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Notes to guide review and interpretation of the reports

- These reports shows the number of students who graduated with majors in each department, annually for the last several academic years. A graduate with more than one major is counted once per major. Each major code is associated with a department.
- Sex refers to legal sex and is recorded by the registrar, usually based on information originally provided in the Common Application. A student may change their legal sex information with the Registrar's office. Students may be recorded with M, F, or X.
- Notes on dates: The registrar only ever records one of three graduation dates in a year: May (with the specific date of commencement used), August, and December. December grads are counted with the following May.
- Technical notes for each report are available in the Excel version of this report. These technical notes are intended to answer questions about what is included and excluded from each report.
